Schillig to present RWC scholarships

This Labor Day, Sept. 5, will be the 17th annual Run with Carl – for which Bettendorf Rotary is the title sponsor. Our own **Dick Schillig**, who founded the



race in 1995, is our featured speaker at the June 1 meeting, when he will introduce the recipients of this year's scholarships. Each year one graduate each of Pleasant Valley and Bettendorf high schools receives a

Carl Schillig scholarship of \$4,000 - \$1,000 for each year in college.

The event memorializes the life of Carl Schillig who was killed in a carpedestrian accident in 1994. The Carl D. Schillig Memorial Fund currently provides scholarships to students attending Iowa State University (3), St. Ambrose University (1), University of Iowa (1), Simpson College (1), Luther College (1) and Evangel University, Missouri (1).

Smith recounts IA Senate highlights

Brian Kennedy stood to introduce the day's speaker and announced that Bruce Rastetter, president and CEO of Hawkeye Renewable Energy and a member of the



State Board of Regents, had been rescheduled to June 15.

Instead, Brian introduced Roby Smith,

the freshman state senator who represents most of Bettendorf and eastern Davenport, who offered some of his perspectives after his first legislative session.



Roby related

several anecdotes, including one from his campaign, when a voter kissed him on the forehead – and he asked her if he could put a campaign sign in her yard. That experience led him to observe, Forrest Gump-like, that campaigning door-to-door was "like a box of chocolates – you never know how it's going to turn out." Saying "I work for you," the district's voters, he related some of the emotion of serving as a

freshman in the State Senate – sitting at the same desk where now Lt. Gov. Kim Reynolds worked... having dinner once at the same table as Gov. Branstad... certifying the election results... breakfasting with Rep. **Linda Miller**.

Smith has standing assignments on the Education, State Government and Ways and Means committees and is a member of the Justice System Appropriations Subcommittee of the Senate.
