Bettendorf Family YMCA



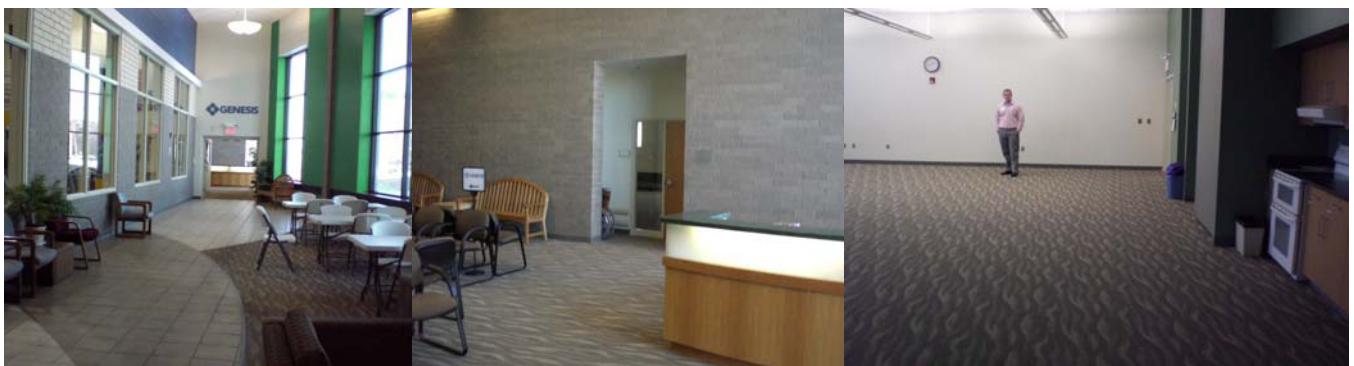
Nicole announced last week that our meeting on Wednesday, February 11th will be held at the Bettendorf YMCA. We will not meet at Fortune Gardens.

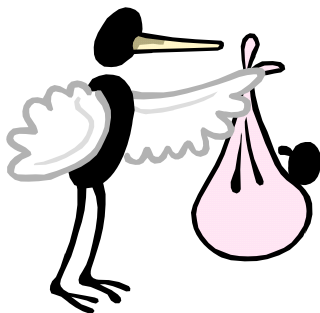

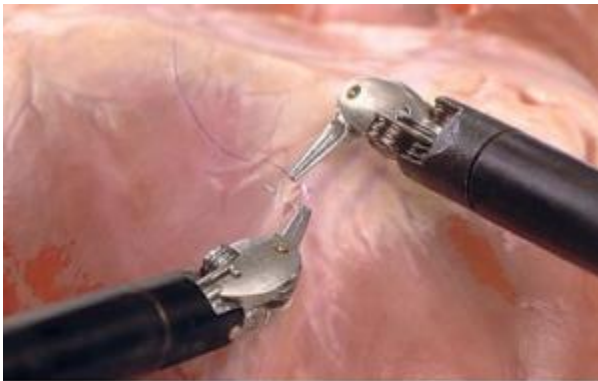
Andrea Coleman, CEO Trinity Regional Health System

Last week Trinity Regional Health System's new President and CEO, Andrea Coleman spoke at our meeting.

Ms Coleman presented a strong speech about Trinity's commitment to quality and excellence, and it's dedication to providing healthcare to the residents of the QC. She added, "It is a great privilege to serve the Quad-City community."



Coleman is proud to say Terrace Park is having it's 5th Birthday and even though the world is in a bit of a turmoil, the Quad Cities has been very good to them. Trinity is now offering its first Robotic surgery for prostate and hysterectomy procedures. The da Vinci System will improve a patient's experience during minimally invasive surgery and allow surgeons to move toward perfecting their craft, she said. Infection rates are also driven down by improving care, which in turns improves your cost. Coleman also mentioned that 36% of Americans are not getting



health care, mostly because their afraid to spend a dollar. We hope that mind set will change once they realize they could have a longer healthier life with proper healthcare.
