With a mission based in Matthew 28, The 180 Zone works “with local churches, organizations and communities” to realize the vision to “bring love, hope and opportunity to those in crisis situations.”

The scheduled speaker at our June 25 meeting is **Rusty Boruff** who will elaborate on the four fundamental components of The 180 Zone’s mission:

- ➔ **Residential:** “...to house those who need more care for their present state of mind, physical situation and spiritual health.”
- ➔ **Discipleship:** “... to disciple those we reach through outreach ministries.”
- ➔ **Outreach:** “... to reach those in the community and funnel them into Residential and Discipleship ministries.”
- ➔ **Preventative:** “... to stop crisis, poverty, addictions and criminal behavior before it cultivates in the lives of our children and young adults.”

Decker Ploehn acted as auctioneer for the annual auction of leftover potent potables – which added \$730 more to the LobsterFest pot.

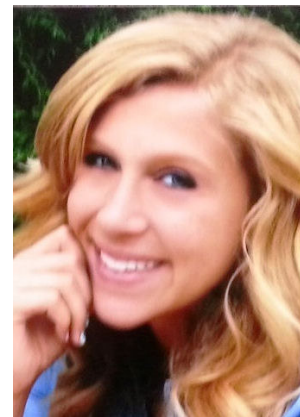

In 1958: 22 members brought 5 guests. Al Plumb opened the meeting and the song was "America."

In 1969: **Chuck Mooney** was absent. I had to mention it, because, well, that happened less than Halley's Comet. And the meeting opened with... "America."

1980: Jim McNamara opened the meeting with..... "America." Joe Whittey spoke about his new restaurant idea, "Happy Joe's."

1986: The club leadership proposed increasing the annual budget by \$6,000, to \$42,508.

1997, 2003: I don't know what happened in 1997 or 2003; I haven't scanned those minutes yet!
